

Centennial Diving 2011-2012 Program and Pricing Information

Group Descriptions and Practice Times-

Blue - \$125 per month

- 2 days/week – Mon/ Wed 5:30-6:30 Sat 12-1:30 @ LaSalle University
- Divers must choose two out of the three days offered, choices may be limited to make class sizes manageable
- Practice begins Sat Sept 17th
- Starts future divers with the fundamental skills and basic dives of the sport with a focus on safety and fun. Great for younger summer league divers and new divers.

Orange – \$195 per month

- 3 days/week – Mon/Wed 5:30-7 Sat 12-1:30 @ LaSalle University
- Practice begins Saturday Sept 17th
- Great for divers who have already competed in a summer league and are looking to learn more advanced dives and improve their skills in a fun team atmosphere
- Divers will learn both one and three meter boards
- Divers will compete in AAU invitational meets and are welcome to compete in the US Diving meets if they are ready.
- After 3 months divers will be evaluated if they are ready to advance to the JO level

Gold – \$195 per month

- 3 days/week – Mon/Wed 6-7:30, Sat 10:30-12 @ LaSalle University
- Practice begins Saturday Sept 17th
- Based on evaluation from Orange level
- For younger divers developing basic skills and are interested in developing a competitive JO list of dives for both 1 and 3 meter boards.
- Divers must make a commitment to compete on the AAU and US Diving Circuit.

Junior Olympic - \$240 per month

- 5 days/week – Mon/Wed/Thurs 6:30-8:45 – Fri 6:00-8:30 – Sat 9-12 @ LaSalle University
- Practice begins Saturday Sept 17th
- For divers who have mastered basic skills and are interested in further developing a competitive list of dives for competition on both 1 and 3 meter boards.
- Divers must make a commitment to compete on the AAU and US Diving Circuit.
- This program is a 11 month commitment

High School – \$360 per session

- This group will be divided into two 3 month sessions
Session #1-Sept, Oct, Nov and Session #2- Dec, Jan, Feb
- 2 days/week – Tues 5:30-7:00 – Sat.10:30-12:00 @ LaSalle University
 - Practice begins Saturday Sept 17th
 - For all divers looking to improve their skills and begin learning more advanced dives for the high school competition season
 - One meter board focus only

Weekend Warriors – Skills and Drills - \$35 per 2 hour session –

- Families will be contacted to register when dates and times are set.
One to two weekend days per month – Sat or Sun
Held at Wm Tennent or LaSalle University
Clinic opportunity for any SAL or current team member

**** All times/days are based on pool availability. Times may change to provide the most ideal practice environment for the athletes and coaches.**

**** All practices are held at LaSalle University unless notified.**

Payments –

- Late payments made 10 days after due date will be assessed \$10 late fee
- If a member family is delinquent in the monthly payment by more than 30 days, the next billing statement will include a one month security deposit in addition to any outstanding balances and late fees.

Miscellaneous Fees

- All families will be responsible for a yearly one-time non-refundable Administrative Family Fee of \$85 .00
- Every athlete will have a yearly facility use fee of \$160
- Each diver is required to join AAU – yearly fee \$14
- US Diving Registration – Junior Olympic Divers only-yearly fee \$125 – will be billed
- Fundraisers- **Every family** will be required to participate in the Scrip Fundraising program by ordering a minimum order of \$50 scrip profit split between the team and the family. Contributions of the \$50 will be billed if you do not participate.

Meets –

- Centennial Divers attend approximately 6 meets a year as a team sanctioned by AAU and/or US Diving.
- Each team member will be billed for meet fees (approx. \$30 per event), coaching fees (\$25 per event). Additionally, the costs for travel (airfare, mileage, room, meals, misc.) associated with sending a coach or coaches to a meet will be split evenly amongst all team members entered in the meet.
Every 10 divers there may be another coach covered (for example: 30 divers- up to 3 coaches covered)
- Divers who choose not to attend a meet that are deemed “team travel” meets (unless medically unable or deemed not ready by the coach) will be expected to contribute to the team by paying their portion of meet, coaching, and travel fees that are assigned per diver.

Discounts and Refunds-

- Families will receive a 10% discount in monthly fees for the 2nd child
- No Refunds will be given after Oct 15th. Any refunds on fees only prior to Oct 15th will be subject to a \$50 processing fee. Refunds are not available at any time for pool fees, administrative fees, or fundraising fees.
- There is a two week e-mail notification that is required for any athlete choosing to leave the program. An e-mail from Centennial Diving Administrators will be issued to confirm your departure from the program. In the event that notification is not received, members are responsible for their monthly payment.

Parent Handbook

All parents will receive a parent handbook in the fall with pertinent information for your diver. This handbook will have valuable team information and give clarification on all team policies. Parents will be required to sign off and return paperwork confirming they have read and understand team policies and information.
